

## Murphys Creek Road overpass and Postmans Ridge Road realignment , Postmans Ridge TOOWOOMBA SECOND RANGE CROSSING

As part of work on the Toowoomba Second Range Crossing (TSRC), Nexus is constructing the Murphys Creek Road overpass and Postmans Ridge Road realignment.

These works include constructing:

- a new section of Postmans Ridge Road to connect the existing eastern end of Postmans Ridge Road to Murphys Creek Road
- the Murphys Creek Road overpass across the TSRC
- a cul-de-sac at the western end of Postmans Ridge Road, which will include a turnaround area suitable for heavy vehicles.

Murphys Creek Road overpass and Postmans Ridge Road will maintain connectivity for the local traffic network after the TSRC is built.

Motorists will not be able to access the TSRC from Murphys Creek Road.



### Working Hours

Works will be undertaken during standard construction hours, which are 6:30am to 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday. Out-of-hours works may occasionally occur. Residents will be notified prior to out-of-hours works commencing.



### Traffic impacts

In early 2017, temporary traffic lights will be installed on Postmans Ridge Road and Murphys Creek Road to allow construction vehicles to safely access the TSRC corridor.

Traffic will then be diverted while the Murphys Creek Road overpass is built.

Once the Murphys Creek Road bridge is complete, traffic will be permanently switched to Murphys Creek Road and work will commence to cul-de-sac Postmans Ridge Road (western side).

Motorists and nearby residents will be notified in advance about changes to Postmans Ridge Road and Murphys Creek Road. Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.

Road users will experience changed traffic conditions including lane closures, reduced speed limits, delays of up to five minutes and detours while these works are undertaken.

Traffic control and signage will be used, as required, to direct motorists safely through the work area.
