

STATIM-YAGA PROGRAM

OVERVIEW

The Statim-Yaga program is provided in partnership with funding from Construction Skills Queensland (CSQ) and is at no cost to the selected participants.

The Nexus Delivery and Gold Coast School of Construction (GCSC) Statim-Yaha program's primary objective is to assist career seekers to attain the necessary skills and experience to be able to gain employment in the Construction Industry.

The Program will provide dynamic industry based training for career seekers in the South East Queensland region.

The candidates selected to attend the Program will be under instruction 5 days a week for a maximum 12 week duration.

They will complete an entry level qualification along with work experience (SWL)*, Personal Development Program and Green Skills Training.

*Structured Workplace Learning is designed to give the participant exposure to as many different career options as possible by observing workers in their environment.

PROGRAM OUTLINE

The selected candidates are involved in a variety of construction projects and are immersed in a fully operational construction environment.

The program is underpinned by technical training and career education all integrated into a genuine workplace environment over a course lasting 12 weeks.

Students who complete the program will complete:

- Certificate I in Construction
- 160 hours of Structured Workplace Learning*
- 38 hours Personal Development Program
- Green Skills Training

The program is competitive, challenging, and designed to develop graduates who are highly motivated, independent learners, industry career path 'savvy' and have technical, social and leadership skills that would make them highly sought after by industry.

By being themed around real construction projects, the students have direct exposure to a variety of construction trades and professions.

- Personal development

EXPECTATIONS / PRE-REQUISITES

We are looking for candidates who have either graduated from or left school and have decided they want a career in the construction industry. Entry will be very competitive, so applicants will need to:

- Be passionate and committed about entering the construction industry
- Have a Drivers Licence or be close to obtaining one
- Be able to travel to our campus and to construction sites in your region
- Be competent in prevocational maths and english

ELIGIBILITY

- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or a permanent resident
- Be a Queensland resident
- Have not completed a Certificate I in Construction previously
