



Boundary Street, Cranley

TOOWOOMBA SECOND RANGE CROSSING

As part of work on the Toowoomba Second Range Crossing (TSRC) a grade separated interchange will be constructed at the northern end of Boundary Street, Cranley.

This involves constructing:

- an on-ramp, enabling eastbound motorists to access the TSRC
- an off-ramp, enabling motorists travelling west on the TSRC to exit onto Boundary Street
- a two-lane bridge, taking Boundary Street over the TSRC.

An approximately 600m long section of Boundary Street will be realigned to improve conditions for road users. Once constructed, traffic will be switched onto the new road and the section of existing road will be removed.

The Boundary Street interchange does not include access for eastbound motorists exiting the TSRC, or westbound motorists entering the TSRC. These movements can be made via interchanges at Warrego Highway, Charlton and Mort Street, Cranley.



Traffic impacts

A temporary road will be built to the east of the realignment works, to maintain traffic access along Boundary Street during the road and bridge construction.

Traffic is expected to be permanently diverted onto the new section of Boundary Street in 2017, enabling construction to commence on the TSRC and the ramps.

During construction, road users will experience changed traffic conditions, including reduced speed limits, lane closures, short delays and detours. Traffic control and signage will be used, as required, to direct motorists safely through the work area.

Nexus is committed to keeping the community informed about upcoming works and possible traffic impacts.



Boundary Street Connection Road

Toowoomba Regional Council (TRC) is upgrading Boundary Street to connect with the realigned section of Boundary Street and improve access and conditions for heavy vehicles.

These works are planned to be completed in conjunction with the completion of the TSRC in 2018. Please refer to the TRC website for more information about the Boundary Street Connection Road.



Working hours

Works will be undertaken during standard construction hours, which are 6:30am to 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday. Out-of-hours works may occasionally occur between 8:00pm and 5:00am. Residents will be notified prior to out-of-hours works commencing.

Residents can visit the TSRC Visitor Information Centre located at the project’s site office on Bedford Street, Cranley. Opening hours are Monday to Friday, 9:00am to 5:00pm. The centre is also open outside these times by appointment. Visitor Information Booths are open at the Lockyer Valley Cultural Centre and Toowoomba City Library. These displays are open as per each centre’s opening hours and will be regularly updated with the latest project information.
